



SUSPENSION, WITHDRAWAL OR REDUCTION POLICY

The management of Bureau of Assessment Services (BAS) understands that the aim of management system certification is to inspire confidence from the public and interested parties that an organization certified or verified by BAS fulfills specified requirements. In this context, to uphold the value of certifications, BAS maintains the below policy for suspension, withdrawal or reduction of the scope of certification, which specifies the subsequent actions by BAS Certifications.

Suspension and Withdrawal

BAS shall suspend certification in the following cases:

1. The client's certified management system has persistently or seriously failed to meet certification requirements, including requirements for the effectiveness of the management system;
2. The certified client does not allow surveillance or recertification audits to be conducted at the
3. required frequencies;
4. The certified client has voluntarily requested a suspension.

Additional specific reasons for suspension by BAS include:

1. Major nonconformities that could result in nonconforming product
2. Failure to close a major NCR in the required time frame
3. Failure to meet the conditions of the certification agreement

Under suspension, the client's management system certification is temporarily invalid.

Time

Suspension would not exceed six (6) months. Suspension leading to Withdrawal is used when a client has failed to meet the terms of the Certification Agreement. If more than six months' elapse, the certificate shall be withdrawn or scope shall be reduced, except in emergency situations due to force majeure.

Reduction of Scope

In lieu of Suspension, BAS may reduce the scope of client certification to exclude the parts not meeting the requirements, when the certified client has persistently or seriously failed to meet the certification requirements for those parts of the scope of certification. Any such reduction shall be in line with the requirements of the standard used for certification.

Restoration

BAS will restore the suspended certification if the issue that has resulted in the suspension has been resolved. Technical reviewer of BAS decides if the client has taken sufficient action to resolve the reason for suspension in sufficient time.

Failure to resolve the issues that have resulted in the suspension in a time established by BAS will result in withdrawal or reduction of the scope of certification.

In all cases of suspension, withdrawal or reduction in scope and in restoration, the status will be updated in the BAS client database and in the website in not more than fourteen (14) working days.

BAS makes the agreement about certification withdrawal with the client to ensure the client shall stop using every promotion material related to certification when the client is informed the notification of withdrawal.

BAS makes publicly accessible information about the certification status of a given certification through its website: www.bascertification.com. On demand by the person concerned, the status of the client's management system is clarified whether it is under suspension, withdrawal or reduction condition.
